Osceola School District's Professional and Technical High School (PATHS) To Hold Informational Meetings Regarding Admission For 2012/2013 School Year

Osceola School District's Professional and Technical High School (PATHS) will host an Open House for students and parents interested in attending the school for the 2012/2013 school year. Informational meetings will take place on Saturday, February 4, 2012, from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Informational presentations will be held in the cafeteria every hour beginning at 8:15 a.m.

PATHS offers full academic studies including Honors, Advanced Placement, and Dual Enrollment. Students who attend the school have the opportunity to learn skills and techniques that will carry them into a successful professional career. The school offers specialized programs in the areas of Automotive, Business Computer Programming, Administrative Office Specialist, Culinary, Digital Design, Legal Administrative Specialist, Drafting, Web Design, Medical Administrative Specialist, Electrical, Web Programming, Medical Assistant, HVAC, Wireless, and Pharmacy.

Any Osceola County middle or high school student may apply to attend PATHS and receive transportation. Applications are available at the school, online, and will also be available at the meetings. All students who are planning to attend the school will be required to take an entrance exam. Eligible students must meet the following criteria:

- Have at least a 2.0 Cumulative GPA;
- Good attendance;
- Good discipline record;
- Take an entrance exam (TABE); and
- An interview may be required.
